LB 921 defines the term “Farm Building” for the State Electrical Act.

Section 2 clarifies that the State Electrical Act does not require a license for any person employed for the purpose of constructing a farm building and doing work for which a license would otherwise be required as long as certain conditions apply.

Based on the way “Farm Building” is defined and the potential number of licenses, the State Electrical Board estimates a potential revenue loss related to fewer licenses being needed of (\$110,180) in the first year and (\$120,180) in the second year. There is no basis to disagree with this estimate.
