Explanation of Estimate:

No anticipated fiscal impact. Although LB 1054 has the potential to considerably increase the role of members of the public determined to have standing in contested cases before the Power Review Board, the Board believes it is likely the change would increase the length of hearings and volume of testimony and documentary evidence, not substantially increase the number of hearings conducted by the Board. The length of hearings and volume of evidence would result in some increases in hearing costs, but the Board believes any such increases could be accommodated within the Board's existing budget for hearings.
