Within 30 days of a report to the brain injury registry, this bill would require the Department of Health and Human Services to notify the person with the brain or head injury of the resources available in the Nebraska.

The Department of Health and Human Services would need an additional social service worker to compile and disseminate information to individuals with a brain injury. The costs would be \$56,101 in FY 09 and \$50,949 in FY 10
