LB 867 expands the definition of an abandoned motor vehicle or abandoned all-terrain vehicle or minibike to include those vehicles or minibikes removed from private property by a municipality pursuant to a municipal ordinance. It is unknown how many additional vehicles may be designated as abandoned pursuant to the bill. Municipalities removing vehicles from private property pursuant to LB 867 may incur expenses to remove and store vehicles. These entities may also have increased revenue from the sale of abandoned vehicles in some instances. No fiscal impact can be determined.
