Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 414 eliminates a statutorily (N.R.S. 39-1512) required annual report to be filed by the county highway superintendent with the county board that delineates various financial and non-financial aspects related to the previous year's work performed to improve and maintain public roads in the county. The bill also changes other statutorily required reporting provisions related to county highway superintendents filing reports on planned future county road projects and completed county road projects. No fiscal impact to the state is present.

It is presumable there would be a reduction in workload for counties due to the removal of certain reporting requirements as less time would be spent by staff to maintain and compile records related to the specific report.

Douglas and Lancaster counties were asked to provide a fiscal note but did not respond by the required date.
