Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 575 requires each school district to adopt a policy to provide military recruiters with access to routine directory information for each student in a high school upon request. Routine directory information means a student’s name, address and telephone number. Schools are to notify parents of the option to submit a written request to not have the information released to military recruiters. Schools are required to adopt a policy to provide military recruiters with the same access to high school students as is accorded to postsecondary educational institutions or prospective employers.

The bill has no fiscal impact for any state agency. The bill will increase the workload and may increase expenses for school districts to adopt the required policies; inform parents of the option to prohibit the release of routine directory information to military recruiters; and, insure that such information is not provided if a parental objection is filed. Any fiscal impact is dependent upon how a school district complies with the requirements of the bill.
