This bill would change penalty provisions for motor vehicle homicide and motor vehicle homicide of an unborn child.

The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) and the Department of Correctional Services (DCS) both estimate no fiscal impact. DCS notes that the number of inmates in prison for motor vehicle homicide as the most serious offense were 10 in 2006 , and 13 in 2007.
