Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill would prohibit possession by minors of tobacco and nicotine products.

Current law states that if minors use tobacco in any form whatever, they shall be guilty of a Class V misdemeanor (Class V misdemeanor: Maximum — no imprisonment, one hundred dollars fine; Minimum — none).

Because this bill broadens the current law to include possession, it is possible that fine revenue for violations could increase. Any fines assessed pursuant to convictions will accrue to the county where the violation occurs to be used for the support of public schools.

The Department of Revenue estimates that this bill will have no impact on General Fund revenues and there will be no cost for the department to implement the bill.

The Nebraska State Patrol and the Department of Health and Human Services estimate no fiscal impact from this bill.

LB 862 amends the language describing criminal penalties for underage possession or consumption of tobacco products. Section 1 adds possession of cigarettes, cigars, or electronic nicotine devices to the prohibition on underage consumption of these products. Section 2 expands the definition of electronic nicotine delivery system to include products designed to contain nicotine regardless of whether they actually contain nicotine, tobacco, or tobacco derivatives.

It is estimated that this bill will have no impact on General Fund revenues.

It is estimated there will be no cost to the Department to implement this bill.

The operative date for this bill is three months after adjournment.
