Additionally, the Directory may be reappointed and may also be removed by the Governor for the same reasons a Director may be removed by the Commission under current law.

No fiscal impact is apparent.

The Game and Parks Commission indicates there could be an impact in the event a selected director has a salary that is different than the current director salary.

Explanation of Estimate:

The proposed legislation would change provisions related to the appointment and removal of the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission Secretary (Director). Currently the Director is appointed by the Board of Commissioners who are appointed by the Governor. This legislation would have the Governor directly appoint a director as soon as this legislation became effective, and be subject to the confirmation of the Legislature. The director may currently be removed by a majority vote of the commission for cause. The proposed legislation would allow the Governor to remove the director for cause.

The fiscal impact would be dependent upon the salary and benefits of the selected director compared to the current director if the Governor chose to select a new candidate.
