LB 314 adds language in section 44-312 to stipulate that the reimbursement rate for a telehealth consultation shall, at a minimum, be the same as for comparable on-person consultation.

The self-funded insurance programs for the State of Nebraska and the University of Nebraska healthcare plans currently comply with this requirement. There is no fiscal impact for the Department of Insurance.

LB 314 has no fiscal impact.
