**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

LB 486 amends section 84-733.

Currently, section 84-733 prohibits state funds (beginning January 1 of the year in which the Governor is elected and continuing through the day of the general election) from being used for any radio, television, or print media advertising or promotional materials which refer to any one or more of the following state officeholders:

- Governor
- Lieutenant Governor
- Secretary of State or Nebraska State Treasurer
- Attorney General, or
- Auditor of Public accounts

LB 486 eliminates the date range provision resulting in a comprehensive prohibition of such advertisements that include reference to officeholders by name.

The bill does not prohibit such advertisements, only those referring to officeholders by name.
