This bill would authorize the Director of Correctional Services to assign felony offenders to an incarceration work camp as prescribed.

The Department of Correctional Services (DCS) notes that this bill would allow DCS to better utilize capacity at McCook Ethic Work Camp (WEC). There could be an increase in operating costs by placing more inmates at WEC; however, DCS anticipates no additional resources would be needed since the inmate per diem transfers with the inmate.
