LB 180 would amend sections of law relating to solid waste disposal fee rebates and would create a new grant category for the Waste Reduction and Recycling Incentive Fund. It is estimated that the changes contained in LB 180 would not have a significant impact on the total amount of revenue and expenditures paid from the Waste Reduction and Recycling Incentive Fund in Department of Environmental Quality.

LB 180 would create a grant category where cities of the second class, villages and counties with a population of 5,000 or fewer could be reimbursed for the costs of deconstructing abandoned buildings and recovering recyclable materials. This could result in certain political subdivisions receiving grant funding to offset building demolition costs.
