LB 68 prohibits the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) from closing a state operated facility providing residential services to persons with developmental disabilities without specific legislation to authorize such closure. If the department intends to seek legislation to close a facility, then written notice must be provided at least 60 days prior to the next legislative session. The bill also provides procedures to be followed by the department if it intends to seek legislation to close such facility.

The bill does not have a definite fiscal impact. HHS indicates that if the Beatrice State Developmental Center would lose federal funding for the next fiscal year and the facility would need to be kept open pursuant to the bill until legislation was passed to close the facility, there would be a need for additional general funds to continue operating the center.
