LB 134 would have no fiscal impact to state agencies.

LB 134 would prohibit natural resources districts (NRDs) from using the power of eminent domain for the development or management of recreational trails or corridors unless such projects are associated with flood control structures. The fiscal impact on NRDs would depend upon whether such projects are undertaken, the size of the projects and property acquisition negotiations. Costs would vary on a project-by-project basis and can not be estimated.
