This bill establishes classes of swimming pools and expands the type of pools required to have certified operators. The Department of Health and Human Services is responsible for providing swimming pool operator training and certification. The effective date of the act is March 10, 2010.

There are approximately 2,000 additional operators who would need to be trained, tested and certified. The cost would be \$250,000 CF. Revenue from fees would cover the costs.

The Game and Parks Commission operates six pools that would require their personnel operating the pools to attend training. The additional cost would be approximately \$125 per operator. The cost would be approximately \$1,250 to \$2,000 in General Funds annually.
