LB 482 would have no impact on the Department of Natural Resources.

LB 482 would amend the number of public hearings that an affected natural resources district (NRD) be allowed to hold when a river basis, subbasin or reach is determined fully appropriated. Current law states that the NRD may hold one or more public hearings on the question of whether stays on new water well permits, the construction of new water wells or increases in the number of acres irrigated by ground water should be terminated. LB 482 would permit the NRD to hold two or more public hearings. It is estimated that any fiscal impact to affected NRDs would be minimal in nature.
