This bill makes several changes to paternity claims, consent for adoption, the biological father registry, children born out of wedlock and relinquishment of parental rights.

The bill would have minor costs for changes in the biological father registry forms and a shift in costs for genetic testing to Department of Health and Human Services Finance and Support. Those costs can be handled within existing departmental resources.
