Under current law, the membership of (city/county) public building commissions is comprised of five members. Four members of the commission, who are appointed otherwise, appoint the fifth member of the commission. LB233 would require that this fifth member of such commissions be a resident of the county in which the commission is established. Members of public building commissions are eligible to be reimbursed for expenses, including mileage expenses. The county residency requirement contained in LB233 may impact related expense reimbursements to the extent that affected fifth members are not currently county residents.
