This bill will change provisions relating to the Nebraska Police Standards Council. The bill has the emergency clause.

The Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice (Crime Commission) states that this bill will add another member to the Police Standards Advisory Council. The Council meets 10-12 times per year at the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center (NLETC) in Grand Island. The Crime Commission reimburses Council members for travel, lodging and meals.

The Crime Commission notes that currently the reimbursements range from \$55 to \$230 per meeting. The agency estimates travel costs for the new member at \$2,000 per year. This estimate is based on 10 meetings per year and also that the new Council member will live 200 miles from Grand Island (no lodging). Although the Crime Commission's General Fund budget for the NLETC is rather tight, it does appear that the agency should be able to absorb this additional cost within their current budget.
