LB387 would amend the Building Construction Act. Beginning 1/1/08, the act would require that all new residential construction equipped with plumbing is to have water meters and plumbing installed in such a way as to separate potable water used outside the residence from potable water used inside the residence. Beginning 1/1/2015, the requirement would apply to all new construction and all new water service changes. Budgets for state and political subdivision construction projects subject to the requirement would need to accommodate compliance with these provisions as they become applicable.
