LB 464 changes statute to give the Attorney General jurisdiction to enforce the criminal provisions of the Campaign Finance Limitation Act (CFLA).

The Attorney General estimates the need for 0.25 FTE to perform these duties.

Due to the infrequent nature of criminal provisions under the CFLA being enforced, this estimate appears to be unreasonable. According to the Accountability and Disclosure Commission, the most recent criminal violation that was prosecuted under the CFLA was approximately 16 years ago.

No fiscal impact.
