LB 1055 amends the Nebraska Employment Security Law, Nebraska Revised Statutes Sections 48-628.02 and 48-628.03 to clarify the unemployment insurance extended benefit period.

The majority of changes to these sections appear to be harmonizing in nature and to eliminate obsolete language. However, new language in the bill would authorize the state to pay extended unemployment benefits entirely from federal funds, pursuant to Public Law 110-252, prior to the payment of extended benefits as provided for in current statute.

The bill has no fiscal impact to revenue or expenditures.
