LB 969 requires that the term of office for all officers in cities of the second class appointed by the mayor (except regular police officers) and confirmed by the city council shall be established by the city council by ordinance. The ordinance shall provide that either office holders serve until the end of the mayor's term and a successor is appointed or the office holder shall hold office for one year unless sooner removed.

LB 969 also changes provisions related to certain terms of office for villages.
