LB 896 creates an overweight permit to allow the operation of vehicles loaded up to 2% greater than the maximum weight specified by law when carrying livestock from the farm or ranch to market. Permit proceeds are deposited into the Highway Cash Fund. The Department of Roads has estimated permit revenue from this new permit to total approximately \$500 annually. This is based on the assumed issuance of 50 permits at \$10 each.
