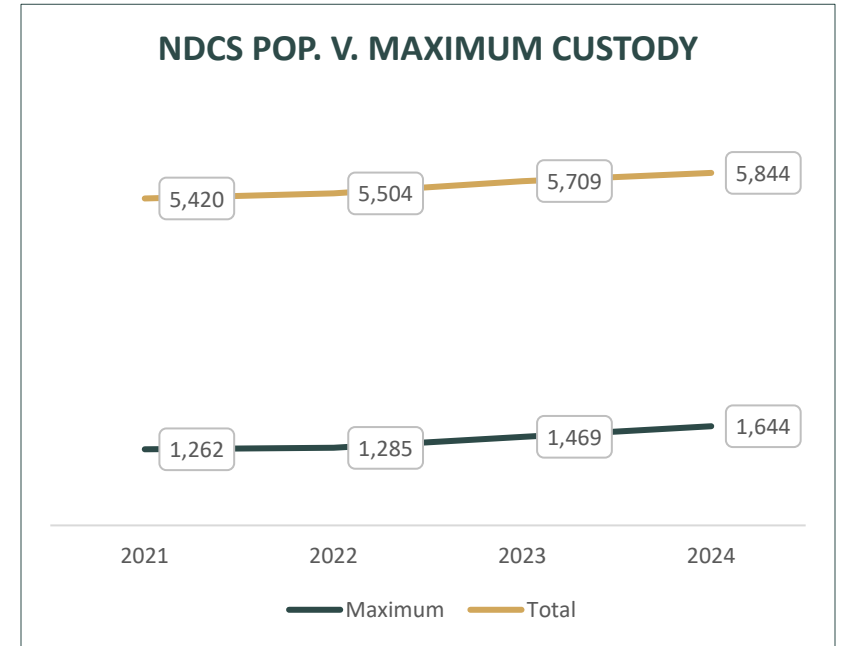
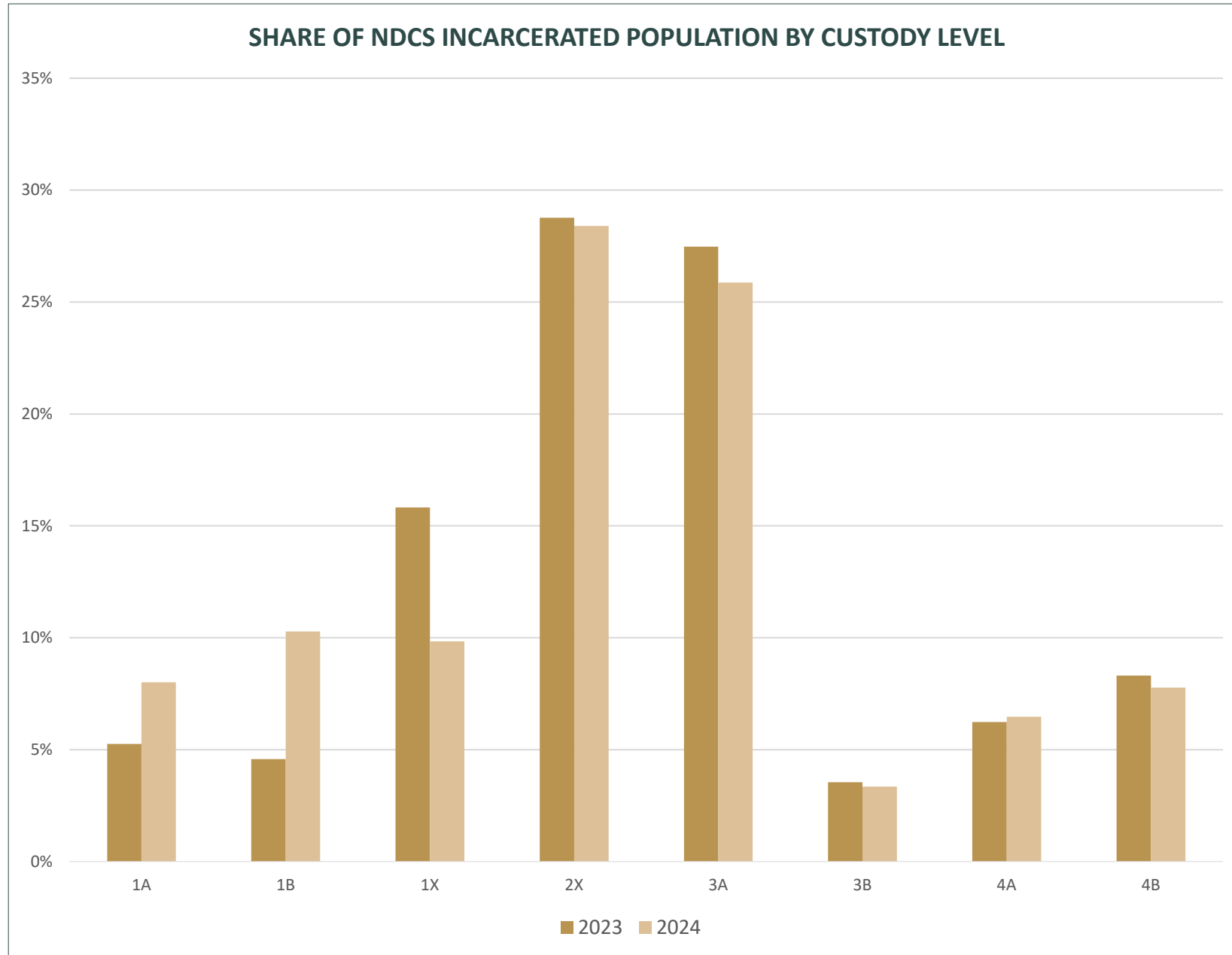

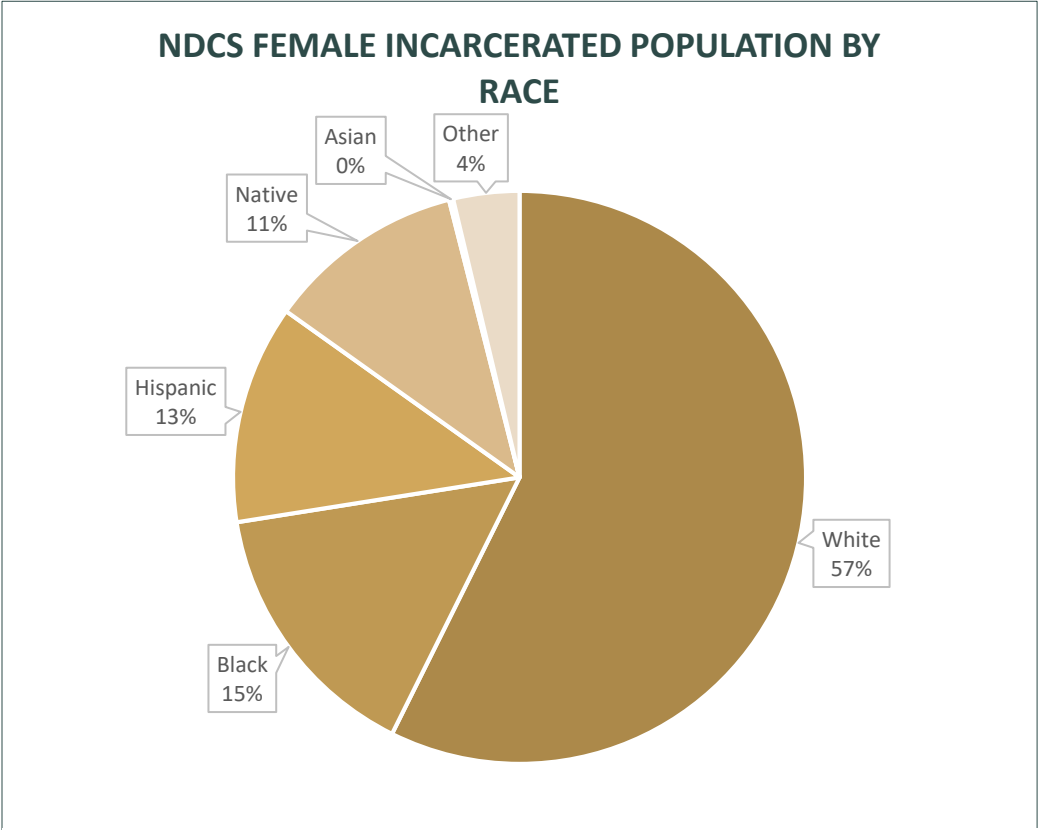

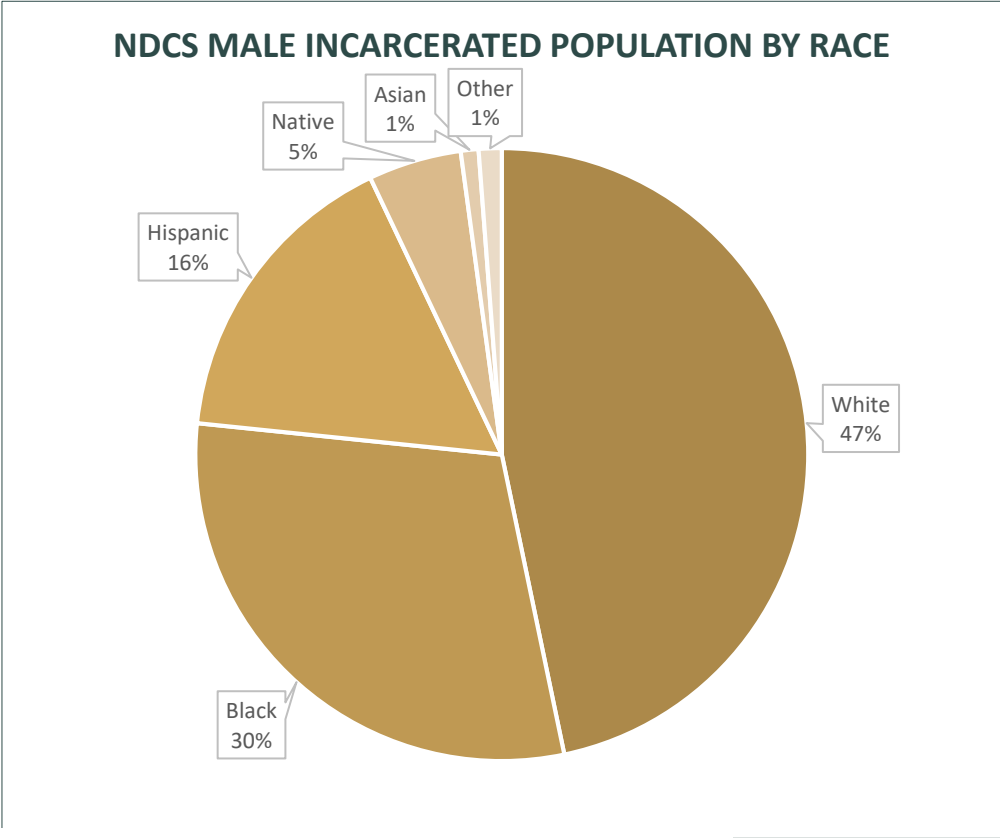
Above: Snapshot counts of the overall NDCS incarcerated population, and those within NDCS who are in maximum custody.

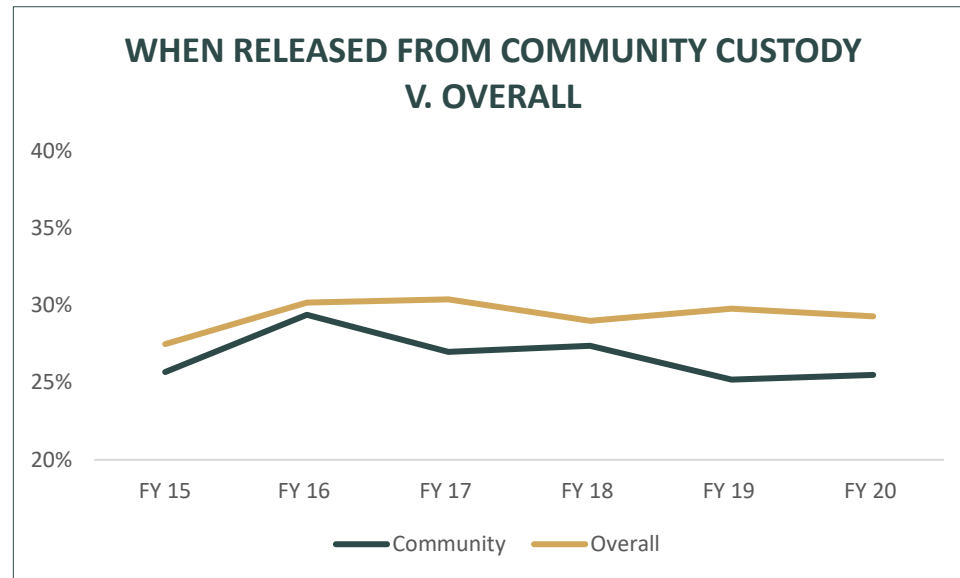
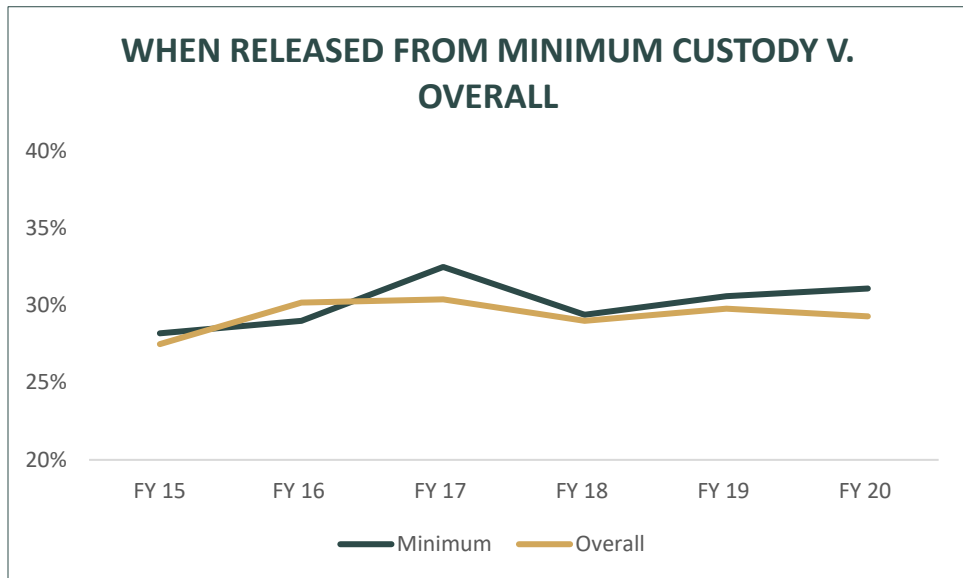
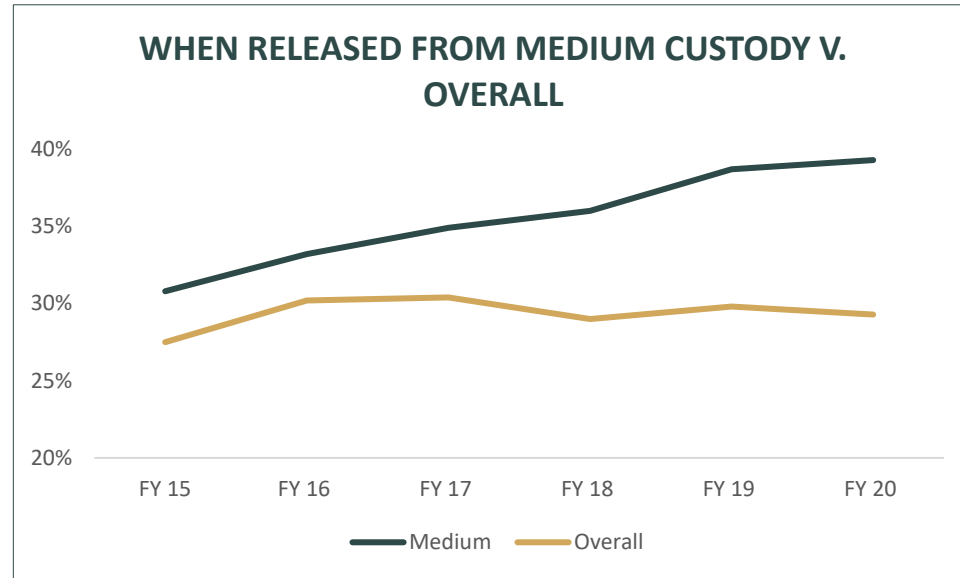
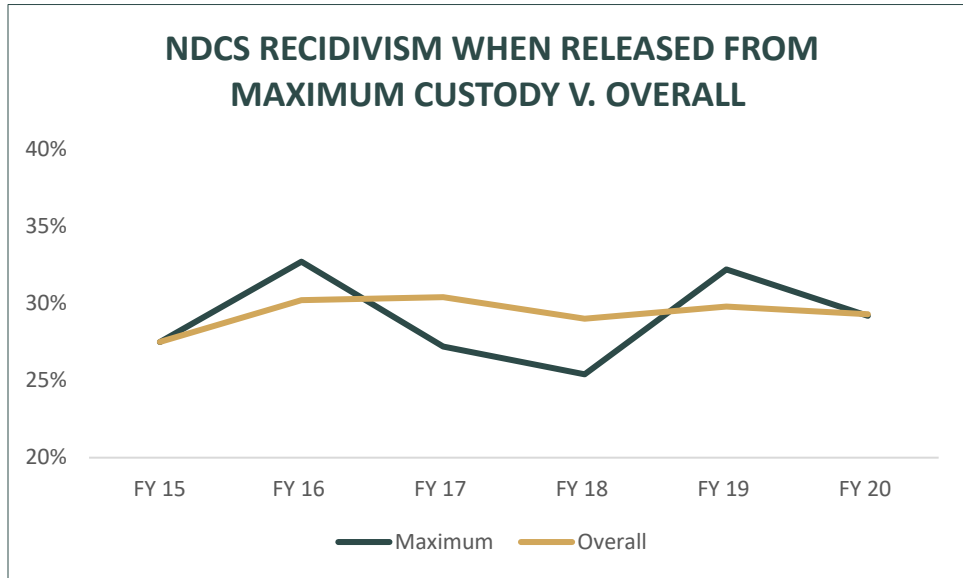

# DATA APPENDIX | CORRECTIONAL POPULATION (RECIDIVISM)

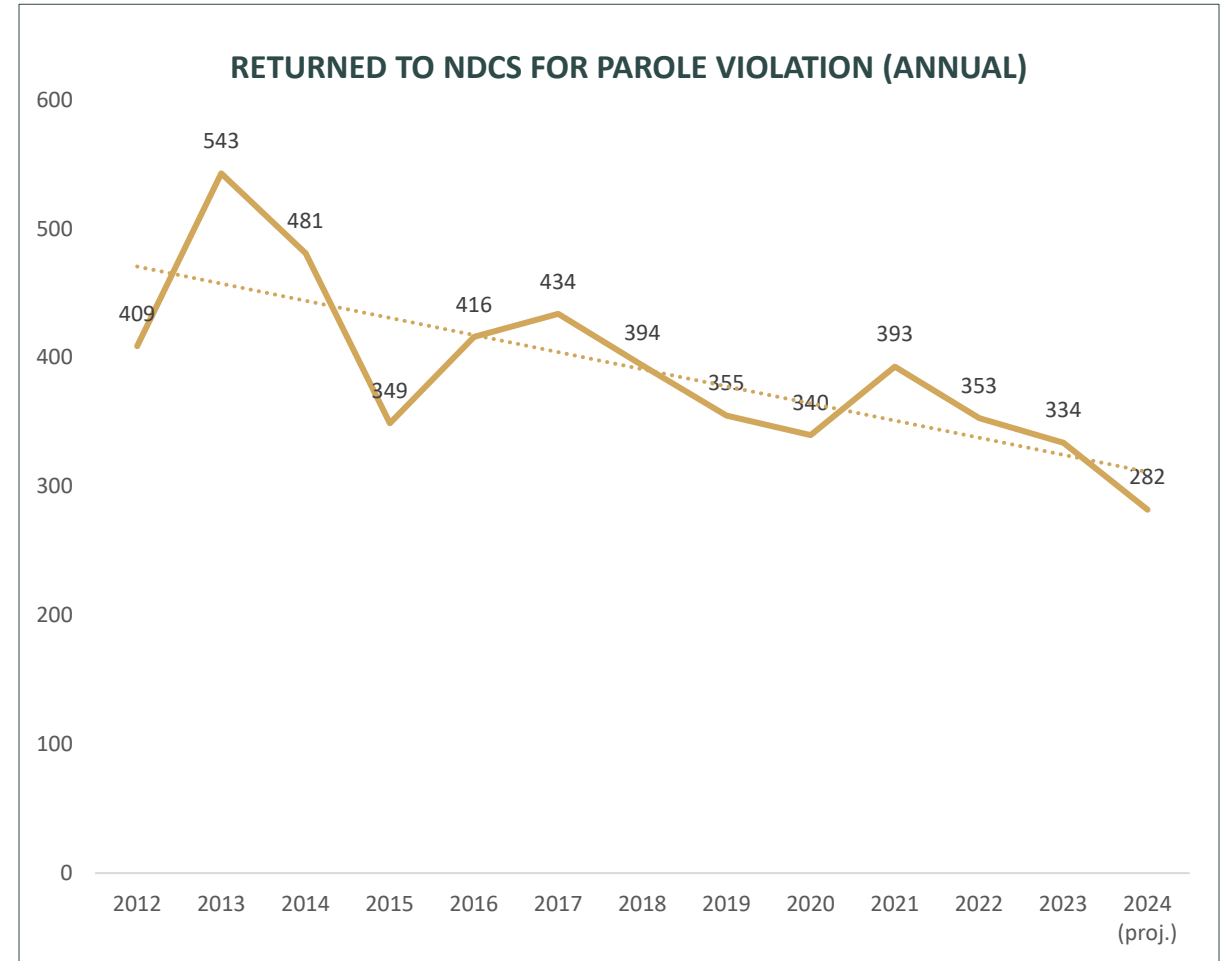
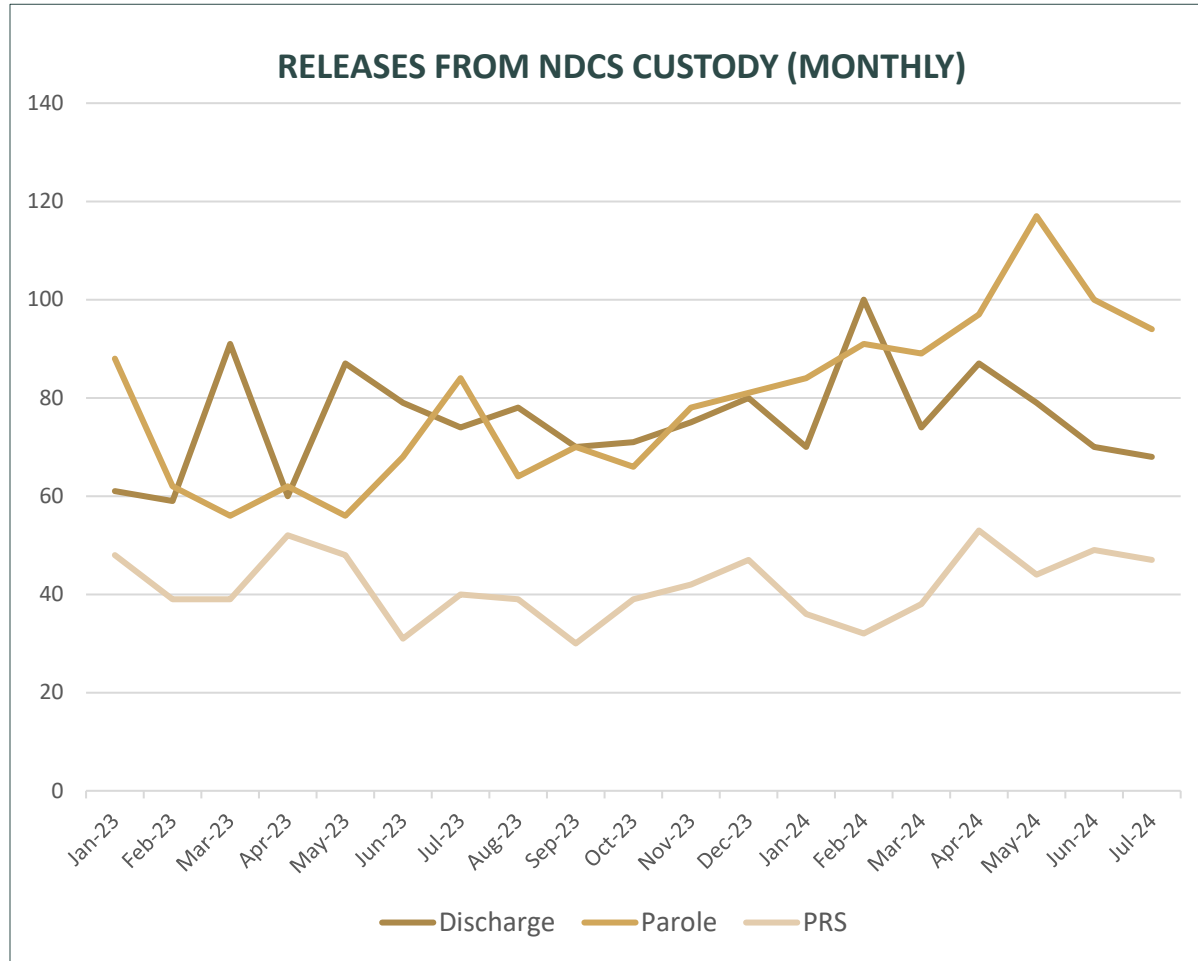


The charts at left each show NDCS' overall three-year recidivism rate, compared with the recidivism rate for individuals released from each custody level within the system. The data is reported based on the year of release, resulting in a lag of three years.

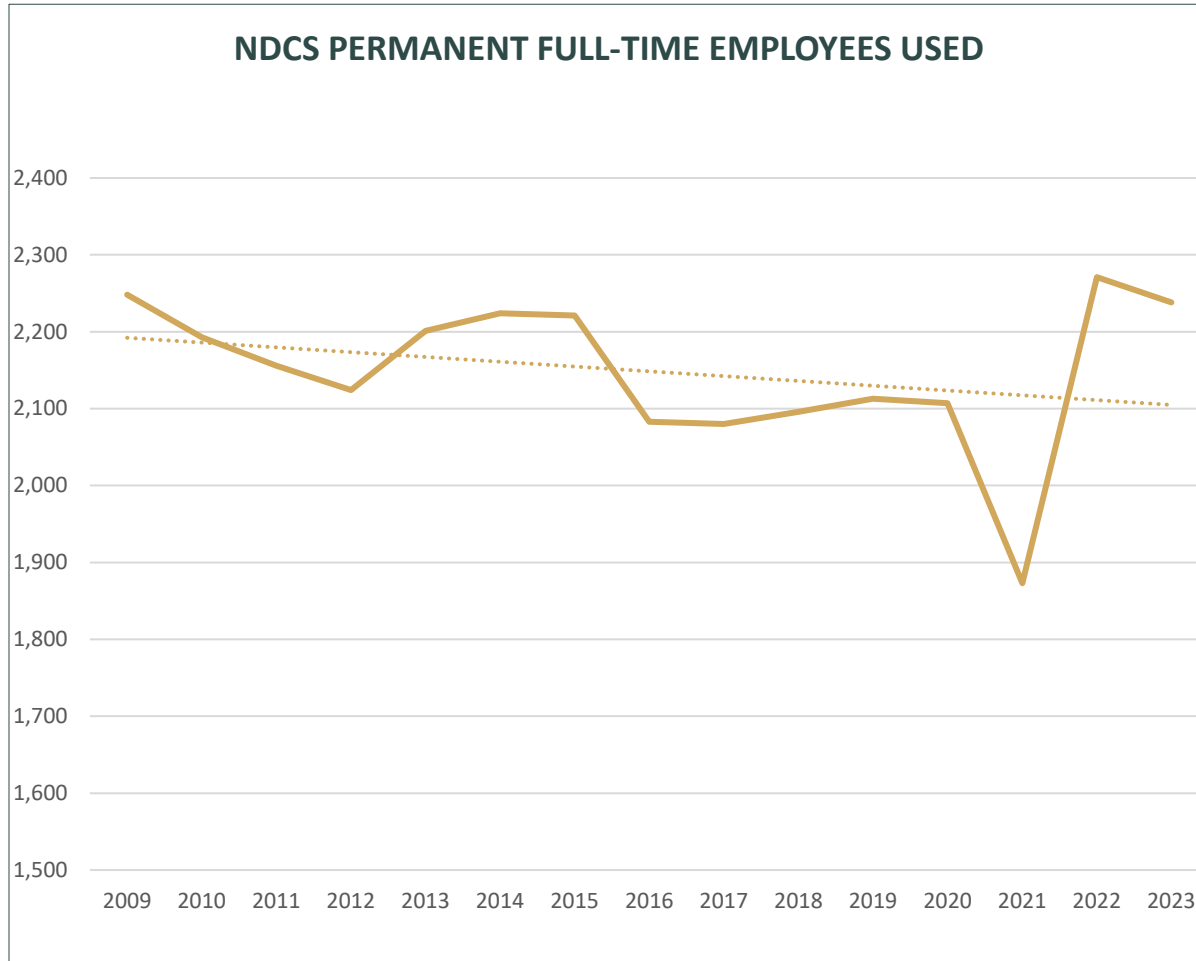
Recidivism is highest among those released from Medium custody, and lowest from Community custody (work release or work detail). Interestingly, rates are comparable for those released from Maximum and Minimum custody. It is worth noting the Maximum custody figure includes individuals who are released directly from an NDCS intake facility.

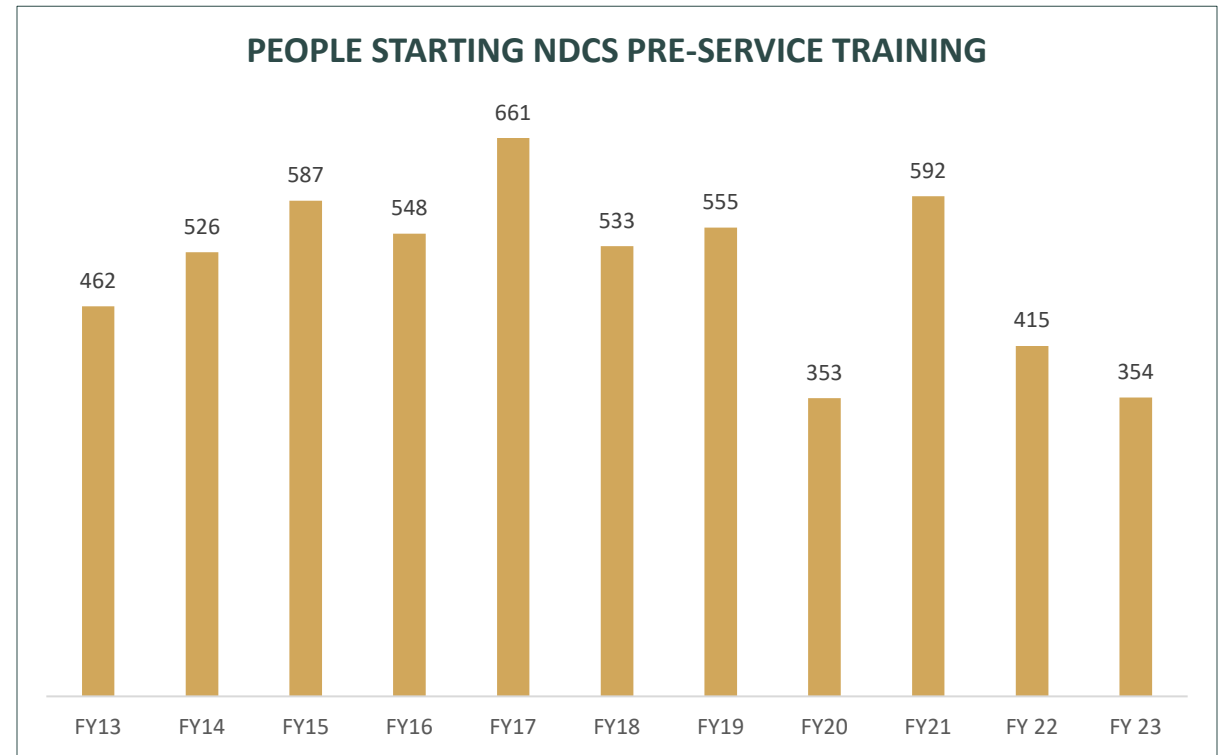

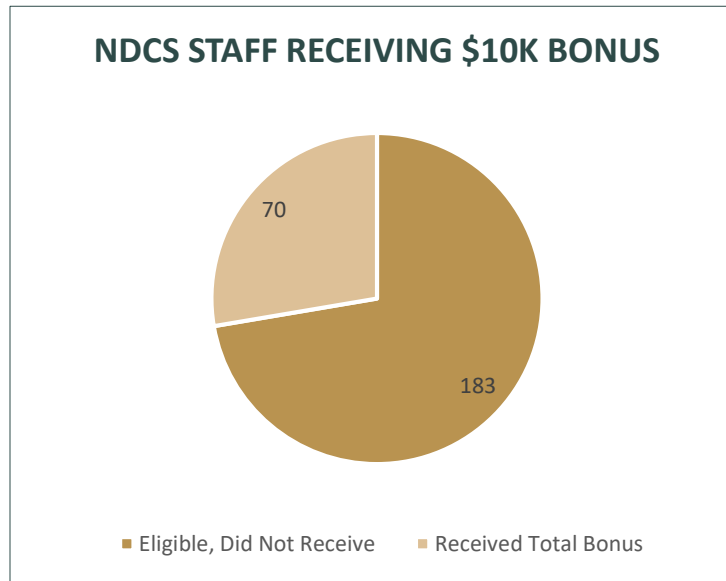
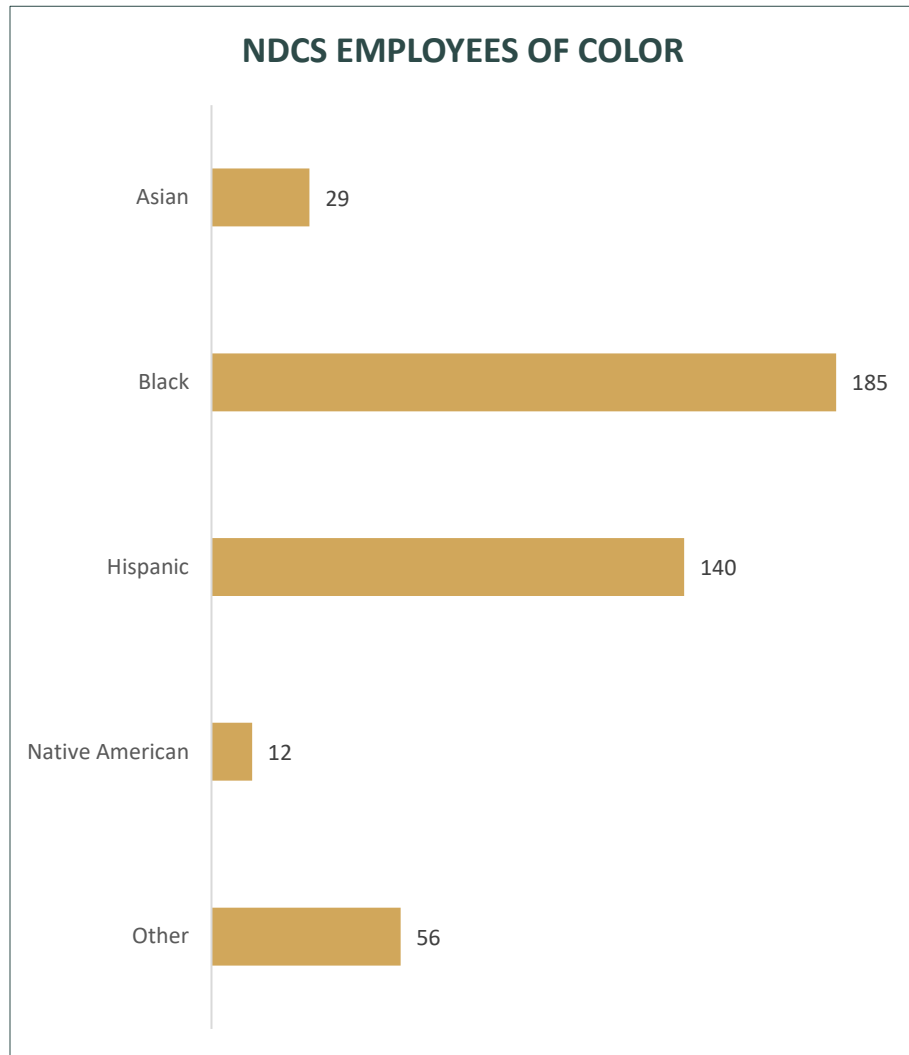
